



# Chapel Favorites Tour

For the first time in history, the nuns' chapel and chancel are open to the public. The cultural mediation team is offering students a truly memorable experience in this place recognized as a Quebecois heritage treasure. Highlights of this must-see historical site include the decor sculpted in the 18<sup>th</sup> century and meticulously gilded with gold leaf by the Ursulines, Marie of the Incarnation's oratory and tomb, as well as 17<sup>th</sup>- and 18<sup>th</sup>-century paintings.

DURATION: 30-MINUTE TOUR

## TOPICS COVERED

- Art

Students explore the different types of art on display in the chapel—paintings, sculptures, statues, gildings and silverwork.

- Events

Students discover the site, which has witnessed important events in our history. They become aware of the consequences of these events and the changes that subsequently arose.

- Time

Students learn about the lifestyles of various people who have spent time at the Ursuline Chapel (nuns, students, the public and historical figures such as Monseigneur de Laval and Lieutenant-General Montcalm, etc.).

## THE TOUR

Students explore the themes presented during their interactive tour of the works in the Ursulines' art collection. Throughout the tour, they participate in the following activities related to the program topics:

- Matching game
- Observation game
- Role-playing game
- Interactive discussion
